IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

1. Nature of Empanelment and No Work Guarantee

This NIT invites applications for empanelment/rate-contract consideration only. Empanelment, technical qualification, acceptance of rates or issuance of a Rate Contract/LOA shall not by itself guarantee any work, quantity, site, value, continuity of work or payment. Actual work shall arise only through a separate written Placement Order/Purchase Order and Work Commencement/Site Release Order issued by an authorised signatory of AMCSL.

2. Award and Competent Approval

A Rate Contract/LOA may be issued only to technically and commercially qualified agencies after evaluation and approval by AMCSL's competent authority. AMCSL may empanel one or more agencies and may accept or reject any bid in accordance with the Tender Documents, without creating a right to award.

3. Portal Registration

Every bidder shall complete Vendor Empanelment Registration on the AMCSL portal before submission. Registration, payment of any applicable portal/empanelment fee or generation of a Vendor Code does not guarantee technical qualification, empanelment or award of work. Any applicable portal/empanelment fee shall be non-refundable and non-transferable, as prescribed on the AMCSL Vendor Portal.

4. Mode of Submission

A bidder may submit its bid either online through the AMCSL Tender/Vendor Portal or offline in two separate sealed covers at the stated address, in accordance with the detailed Tender Documents. A bidder shall use only one submission mode. Multiple or conflicting bids from the same bidder shall be liable to rejection.

5. Two-Cover System

Cover-I shall contain the technical, eligibility, statutory and applicable undertaking documents. Cover-II shall contain only the Financial Bid in the prescribed format. Price information shall not appear in Cover-I. Cover-II of technically disqualified bidders shall not be opened.

6. Bid Security

No cash EMD shall be payable with the bid. The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security of ₹25,00,000/- through Bank Guarantee/Insurance Surety Bond only after issuance of the Letter of Award and completion of applicable legal and regulatory requirements. The Successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security of Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakh Only) through an unconditional Bank Guarantee or Insurance Surety Bond, only after issuance of the Letter of Award and completion of applicable legal and regulatory requirements. However existing empaneled vendors of AMCSL holding a valid and active vendor code as on the bid submission date shall be exempt from furnishing such Performance Security, subject to verification of their empanelment status by AMCSL. No Cash Deposit shall be accepted under this clause.

7. Estimated Value and Availability of Work

The stated estimated value is provisional and subject to AMCSL receiving work, funds, site releases and instructions from its clients/concerned authorities. AMCSL shall not be liable for any bidder's expenditure, mobilisation, inventory, anticipated profit or business expectation arising from this NIT.

8. Rates and Downward Revision

Rates accepted under the Rate Contract shall remain firm for the applicable period unless otherwise stated. If actual annual quantities materially exceed projections, AMCSL may seek a downward revision for the succeeding year. Any revision shall take effect only through a written amendment issued by AMCSL's competent authority.

9. Corrigenda and Clarifications

All corrigenda, addenda, clarifications and responses to pre-bid queries shall be published on the AMCSL website/e-Tender Portal and shall form an integral part of the Tender Documents. Bidders shall regularly check the portal and acknowledge all applicable updates with their bids.

10. Holiday

If the scheduled date of any tender event is declared a holiday, the event shall be held on the next working day at the same time and place unless otherwise notified through a corrigendum.

11. No Authority to Commence Work

No bidder or empanelled agency shall procure specifically for AMCSL, dispatch, mobilise, deliver, install or commence site work merely on the basis of this NIT, empanelment, rate acceptance or LOA. Work may commence only after the applicable written Placement Order/Purchase Order and Work Commencement/Site Release Order are issued by AMCSL.

12. Verification and Misrepresentation

AMCSL may verify any licence, registration, experience certificate, financial statement, OEM authorisation, declaration or other document. False, forged, misleading or materially incomplete information may result in rejection, cancellation of empanelment/award, recovery of loss and other action available under the Tender Documents and applicable law.

13. Right to Cancel or Modify the Tender

AMCSL reserves the right to cancel, withdraw, modify, extend or annul this NIT/tender process, in whole or in part, at any stage before issuance of the final award, without thereby incurring any liability to the bidders. Any such decision shall be communicated through the AMCSL Tender Portal/website.

14. Detailed Tender Documents to Govern

This NIT is only a summary of the tender particulars. The eligibility criteria, scope of work, technical specifications, evaluation methodology, payment terms, performance obligations, termination provisions and other conditions shall be governed by the Detailed Tender Documents and corrigenda issued by AMCSL.

AMCSL intends to establish a reliable panel of technically capable, financially sound and professionally managed agencies for the execution of Solar-Based Street Lighting projects. Empanelled agencies demonstrating competitive pricing, timely execution, statutory compliance, product quality and satisfactory performance may be considered for the issuance of project/site-wise Placement Orders during the contract period, subject to the actual availability and award of work to AMCSL, client/concerned-authority requirements, technical and commercial evaluation, site readiness and written approval by AMCSL's competent authority.

The empanelment is intended to facilitate a transparent, performance-based and long-term professional association for an initial period of one year, extendable for up to two additional periods of one year each in accordance with the Tender Documents. Empanelment shall not, by itself, confer any right to receive work or guarantee any minimum quantity, value, site allocation, revenue or extension.

An opportunity for capable agencies to participate in project/site-wise Solar Street Lighting works through a transparent, competitive and performance-based empanelment process.
